

## PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy of **Ultra Technologies LLC** (the Company or “we,” “us,” and “our”) explains what information we collect when you visit [ultrayield.app/](http://ultrayield.app/) (the “Website”), enter into agreements with us, use our products and services, communicate with us, or otherwise interact with us; how we use and share that information; and the rights available to you. Any reference to “we/us/our” in this Privacy Policy includes its wholly owned subsidiaries or affiliates. This Privacy Policy applies to all of our products and services and to every method by which you access the Website.

### 1. Scope of This Policy

This Privacy Policy covers all information that can reasonably be used to identify, relate to, describe, or be associated with a specific individual or household (the “**Personal Information**”) collected through our Website and through your use of our products and services (including our applications) or other engagements with us.

### 2. Personal Information We Collect

We may collect, store, use, and transfer the following categories of Personal Information:

- a. **Identity Data.** Name, cookie ID, email address, and other identifiers (e.g., date of birth, proof of address where required by law for specific products or services).
- b. **Transaction Data.** Cryptocurrency wallet addresses; details relating to your account; records of cryptocurrency transactions, including deposits and withdrawals; and, where applicable, transactions conducted using our services.
- c. **Device Data.** IP address; device type and model; device keys; device location; browser type and version; operating system type and version; device creation/modification/authentication timestamps; device IDs; and device login history.
- d. **Payment/Billing Data.** If you purchase paid services, we may collect payment card number, expiration date, and billing address via our payment processors.

### 3. How We Collect Personal Information

- a. **Direct Interactions.** You provide Personal Information when you create an account, use our products or services, subscribe to updates, request marketing materials, participate in promotions, engage on our social channels, or contact us.
- b. **Third-Party Services.** We may receive information about you from service providers, payment processors, or partners in connection with your use of our products and services.
- c. **Automated Technologies.** When you visit the Website, use our products or services, or interact with our apps, we collect information via cookies, web beacons, and similar technologies. We may also collect cryptocurrency wallet addresses.

### 4. How We Use Your Personal Information

We use information collected about you (including Personal Information) to:

- a. Present our Website and its contents to you.
- b. Deliver services, including facilitating transactions.

- c. Provide information that you request.
- d. Fulfill any other purpose disclosed when you provide the information.
- e. Notify you about changes to the Website.
- f. Enable participation in interactive Website features.
- g. Perform anti-money laundering and other legal checks.
- h. Carry out purposes described at the time of collection.
- i. Pursue any other purpose with your consent.

**Research and development.** We may use Personal Information for testing, research, analytics, product development, and machine learning to improve user experience, make our services easier and safer to use, and develop new features. We may aggregate, de-identify, or anonymize Personal Information for these purposes.

**Marketing.** We may use Personal Information to market our services, including sending communications, promotions, surveys, news, updates, and events via email, push notifications, in-app messages, and third-party advertising platforms.

**Legal Bases for Processing and Proceedings.** Depending on your location and the activity, we process Personal Information as necessary to perform a contract (e.g., provide the Website and services you request), to comply with legal obligations (including KYC/AML and fraud prevention), with your consent (e.g., essential cookies and non-essential cookies), to protect vital interests, and for our legitimate interests, such as improving and securing the Website; preventing abuse and fraud; managing risk and operations; ensuring internal compliance and audit; communicating with you; responding to inquiries/complaints and enforcing our rights; and supporting advertising/marketing. We may use Personal Information to investigate or resolve claims or disputes related to the services; to comply with laws, regulations, licenses, or agreements; or in response to legal process or governmental requests, including from law enforcement.

**Non-marketing communications.** We may use Personal Information to notify you of updates to our terms, services, or policies, or to send communications not intended for marketing the Company or its partners.

We may use information we collect to show advertisements to target audiences. We do not disclose your Personal Information to advertisers without your consent; however, if you click or interact with an advertisement, the advertiser may infer you meet its targeting criteria.

## **5. Sharing Your Personal Information**

We may share aggregated or anonymized information without restriction. We may disclose Personal Information we collect as described in this Policy:

- a. To our subsidiaries and affiliates.
- b. To contractors and service providers supporting our business under confidentiality obligations and restricted-use commitments.
- c. To our partners in order to provide services to you, subject to confidentiality obligations.
- d. To a buyer or successor in connection with a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale/transfer of some or all the Company assets

(including bankruptcy or similar proceedings) where user Personal Information is among the transferred assets.

- e. To fulfill the purpose for which you provided the information.
- f. To comply with a court order, law, or legal process, including responding to government or regulatory requests.
- g. To enforce our Terms of Use and other agreements, including for billing and collection.
- h. If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of the Company, our customers, or others.
- i. For any other purpose disclosed when you provide the information.
- j. With your consent.

## **6. Permanent Information**

Interactions with blockchain networks (including smart-contract logs and events) may result in certain information being permanently recorded and not capable of alteration or deletion. Blockchains operate independently, and the Company has no control over their immutability.

## **7. Third-Party Websites**

Our Website may link to third-party Websites not affiliated with us. Those Websites have their own privacy policies and practices. We are not responsible for the content or privacy practices of third parties. You should review the privacy policies of every third-party Website you visit.

## **8. Personal Information of Minors**

Our products and services are not directed to individuals under 18. We do not knowingly collect or use Personal Information from minors.

## **9. Cookies and Similar Technologies**

Cookies are small text files placed on your device to store information related to you or your device.

- a. First-party cookies are set by our Website and help us gather analytics and power key features for a better user experience.
- b. Third-party cookies are set by external parties (e.g., advertisers or analytics providers) and may be linked to other information they collect.
- c. Certain Website features may use local stored objects to remember preferences and navigation; these are not managed by standard browser cookie settings.

We use cookies, local storage, and web beacons/pixel tags that fall into the categories shown in our Manage Consent Preferences panel. You can change your choices at any time (non-essential categories require your consent where applicable law requires it).

- a. **Essential (Always Active).** Required to provide core Website functionality (e.g., page navigation, secure login, session management, load balancing, fraud/security prevention, and remembering your consent choices). These cannot be switched off in our systems.
- b. **Analytics.** Help us understand how the Website performs, how visitors interact with pages and features, diagnose technical issues, and improve the user experience. Typical metrics

include pages visited, links clicked, time on page, error diagnostics, and device/browser information. You may disable Analytics in your preferences.

- c. **Personalization.** Allow the Website to remember choices such as username, language, region, and other settings, and to provide enhanced, more personal features (for example, showing local content or remembering your preferred network). Disabling this category may reduce functionality or require you to reenter preferences on each visit.
- d. **Marketing.** Used to deliver advertising that is more relevant to your interests, limit how often you see an ad, and measure the effectiveness of campaigns. These may be set by us or our advertising partners (who may build a profile of your interests with our permission). If you disable Marketing, you may still see ads, but they will be less tailored.

We may also use automatic data collection tools to authenticate users; remember preferences; measure content popularity and ad effectiveness; analyze traffic and trends; and better understand the behaviors and interests of people who engage with our services.

## **10. Managing Cookies and Similar Technologies**

You can enable or disable cookies through your browser's built-in controls and our on-site Manage Consent Preferences panel.

## **11. Security**

We implement industry-standard technical, administrative, and physical safeguards to protect Personal Information against unauthorized access, use, disclosure, loss, theft, alteration, or damage, including encryption of sensitive data. However, no method of Internet transmission or electronic storage is completely secure. The security of your Personal Information also depends on you—please use strong, unique passwords, protect your credentials, and do not share your password.

Although we work to protect your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee the security of information transmitted to our Website.

## **12. Personal Information Retention**

We retain Personal Information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this Policy and as permitted by applicable law. Where you request deletion of Personal Information or your account is terminated, we may continue to retain and use data as allowed or required by law (e.g., for legal, tax, regulatory, or other legitimate business purposes).

## **13. Your Rights Regarding Personal Information**

Depending on your jurisdiction and circumstances, you may have the following rights (subject to verification of your identity and applicable law):

- a. **Right of Access/Information.** Request details about the Personal Information we hold and how we process it.
- b. **Right to Rectification.** Request correction of inaccurate Personal Information.
- c. **Right to Erasure (Right to be Forgotten).** Request deletion of Personal Information in certain cases.
- d. **Restriction of Processing.** Request that we limit processing in certain situations.

- e. **Right to Withdraw Consent.** Where processing relies solely on consent, you may withdraw it at any time (e.g., adjust choices using our Website's cookie tool or unsubscribe from newsletters).
- f. **Opt-outs.** In certain circumstances, opt out of sharing Personal Information with third parties.

Note on blockchains. Public blockchain services are designed to immutably record transactions across distributed networks. Many blockchains allow forensic analysis that could lead to de-anonymization, particularly when combined with other datasets. Because blockchains are decentralized or third-party systems not operated or controlled by us, we cannot erase, modify, or alter Personal Information recorded on such networks.

#### **14. International Data Transfer**

We may transfer your information, including Personal Information, to affiliated entities and third-party service providers across borders from your country or jurisdiction to others worldwide (solely for legitimate business purposes). These destinations may not provide the same level of data protection as your home jurisdiction, and you consent to such transfers.
