

Terms of Use

1. Definitions.

"Interface" means our publicly available Website and any desktop or mobile application that display information about decentralized protocols and allow read-only or transaction-routing functionality.

"Smart Contracts" means autonomous, public blockchain-based code that executes transactions without our control.

"Digital Assets" means crypto assets (e.g., ETH, ERC-20 tokens).

"U.S. Person" has the meaning set forth in Regulation S under the U.S. Securities Act of 1933.

"Restricted Person/Territory" means any of the following: (a) any individual or entity that is listed on, or acting for or on behalf of a person listed on, any sanctions or export-control list administered by the United States (including OFAC's SDN List), the European Union (EU Consolidated List), the United Kingdom (UK HMT Financial Sanctions List), or the United Nations (collectively, the "Sanctions Lists"); (b) any resident, citizen, national, or agent of, or any entity organized, incorporated, or doing business in, a country or region subject to comprehensive sanctions or embargoes, including, without limitation, Belarus, Burundi, Crimea and Sevastopol, Cuba, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Russia, Iran, Iraq, Libya, North Korea, Somalia, Sudan, Syria, Venezuela, and Zimbabwe; or (c) any resident, citizen, national, or agent of, or any entity organized, incorporated, or doing business in, a jurisdiction where use of the Services would be unlawful, including, without limitation, the United States, the United Kingdom, and any Member State of the European Union.

"Service" means the Company's non-custodial, informational Interface (web and/or desktop) and related technical functionality that enable Users to read data from, and submit User-initiated transactions to, Smart Contracts on public blockchains. The Service is a decentralized solution as defined herein and does not provide custody, discretionary management, investment advice, brokerage, execution, or settlement services.

"Decentralized Solution" means a configuration in which (a) transactional logic is executed by autonomous Smart Contracts deployed on permissionless networks, (b) Users retain exclusive control over their Digital Assets and private keys, and (c) the Company cannot unilaterally initiate, cancel, reverse, or reroute transactions, nor guarantee performance, uptime, yields, or outcomes. Any upgradeability, parameter changes, or pausing of Smart Contracts (if available) occurs solely pursuant to on-chain governance or protocol-level controls beyond the Company's unilateral control.

"Direct Smart Contract Interaction" means any deposit to, minting from, or other interaction with the Smart Contracts effected by interacting directly with the Smart Contracts, otherwise than through the Interface and the Company's onboarding, verification and compliance controls.

"Passive Deployment of Capital" (or **"Passive Capital Deployment"**) means the User's voluntary allocation of Digital Assets to pre-parameterized, non-discretionary strategies executed by Smart Contracts—without ongoing human portfolio selection or rebalancing by the Company—where (i) the User initiates each on-chain transaction, (ii) the Company exercises no investment discretion over

the User's Digital Assets, and (iii) no return, yield, APY/APR, airdrop, or capital preservation is guaranteed. For clarity, "**capital**" refers to Digital Assets and not to fiat deposits or bank products.

2. Acceptance of Terms of Use.

- a. These Terms of Use ("**Terms**") are a binding agreement between you and **Ultra Technologies LLC**, a company organized under the laws of Georgia ("**Company**," "we," or "us"). These Terms govern your access to and use of the Company's Website and any related desktop application, including all content, functionality, and Services offered via the Company Website or desktop app (the "**Website**").
- b. Please review these Terms carefully before using the Website. By accessing or using the Website, you acknowledge and agree to be bound by these Terms. If you do not agree, you must not access or use the Website.
- c. The Services are available only to individuals at least 18 years old who are not Restricted Persons and are not located in Restricted Territories. We may restrict or geofence access based on citizenship, residency, location, sanctions screening, or other compliance considerations. You remain solely responsible for complying with all laws applicable to you.
- d. You are solely responsible for ensuring your use of the Services complies with all laws, rules, and restrictions in your jurisdiction. We do not represent that the Services are lawful or available in all jurisdictions.

3. Changes to the Terms of Use.

- a. We may revise these Terms from time to time in our sole discretion. Any updates become effective immediately when posted on the Website. Material changes will be indicated by updating the "Last Modified" date and, where required by law, by additional notice. Changes to the arbitration agreement will not apply retroactively to disputes of which we had actual notice before the effective date.
- b. Your continued use of the Website after revised Terms are posted constitutes your acceptance of those changes. You should check this page periodically to stay informed, as all changes are binding on you.

4. Accessing the Website and Account Security.

- a. We may withdraw, suspend, or modify the Website, or any service or material on it, in our sole discretion and without notice. We will not be liable if all or any part of the Website is unavailable at any time or for any period. From time to time, we may restrict access to some parts of the Website or the entire Website, including to registered users.
- b. You are responsible for: (i) making all arrangements necessary for you to access the Website; and (ii) ensuring that all persons who access the Website via your internet connection are aware of these Terms and comply with them.

- f. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your wallet's private keys and any account credentials used with our Services. Notify us immediately of any unauthorized use of your account or other security breach.
- g. If you select or are provided a username, password, or other security information, you must treat it as confidential and not disclose it to any other person or entity. Your account is personal to you, and you agree not to provide any other person with access to the Website (or portions of it) using your credentials. You agree to promptly notify us of any unauthorized access or use of your username or password or any other security breach, and to log out at the end of each session. Use particular caution when accessing your account from a public or shared computer to prevent others from viewing or recording your password or personal information.

5. Permitted Use.

- a. You may use the Website for informational purposes only, to support your own research, due diligence, and decision-making. You must verify the accuracy of any information or transaction messages before relying on them.
- b. You acknowledge that violating these Terms may expose you to civil or criminal liability, monetary damages, and/or termination of your account.
- c. You must promptly notify us of any fraudulent, unauthorized, illegal, or suspicious use of the Services or any other security breach or unauthorized/illegal activity you reasonably suspect.

6. Intellectual Property.

- a. - c. You are not a resident, citizen, national, or agent of, and are not an entity organized, incorporated, or doing business in, any Restricted Jurisdiction.
- d. You agree not to: (i) make any representations, warranties, or guarantees on our behalf or about the Company, the Website, or any content/data on the Website; (ii) make false or misleading statements regarding the Company or the Website or any content/data on the Website; or (iii) engage in any illegal, deceptive, misleading, fraudulent, unethical, or improper practices on, through, or in connection with the Website.

- p. You understand the Interface is non-custodial; we do not control or operate Smart Contracts, validator nodes, liquidity pools, lending/borrowing platforms, or other on-chain functions and cannot reverse transactions.
- q. You represent you are not a Restricted Person and are not located in a Restricted Territory; if a Service is designated as unavailable to U.S. Persons or to persons in the United Kingdom, you will not access such Service.
- r. No Investment Advice. You acknowledge that nothing on or through the Interface constitutes investment, legal, accounting, or tax advice or an offer/solicitation for financial products, securities, or commodities.

In the event of any hack, exploit, security breach, key compromise or other unauthorized or malicious activity affecting the Smart Contracts or the protocol, you acknowledge and agree that all affected tokens or Digital Assets may be burned, frozen or rendered non-transferable at protocol level in order to contain or mitigate such event, and you irrevocably waive any claim against the Company in respect of such action, save for any claim arising from fraud or wilful misconduct to the extent it cannot be excluded under applicable law.

15. Non-Custodial and No Fiduciary Duties.

The Website and Services are strictly non-custodial. We never have custody or control of your digital assets. You are solely responsible for protecting your private keys and wallet credentials, and you should never share your seed phrase or credentials with any unauthorized party. We assume no responsibility or liability for your use of a wallet and make no representations about Website compatibility with any specific wallet. Your wallet is your responsibility, and we are not liable for actions or omissions resulting from a compromised wallet. This Agreement does not create or impose any fiduciary duties on us. To the maximum extent permitted by law, you acknowledge and agree that we owe no fiduciary duties or liabilities to you or any other party, and any such duties or liabilities that may exist at law or in equity are irrevocably disclaimed, waived, and eliminated.

16. Suspension.

- a. Your account will be suspended if we cannot complete payment transactions for our Services. The account will remain functional, but all service requests will be rejected for lack of funds and execution of pending Services will be suspended. Charges may continue to accrue. Suspension ends only after all outstanding balances are settled.
- b. We may suspend your access if we reasonably believe your use violates applicable law or these Terms.

17. Termination.

- a. We may terminate or suspend your access to all or part of the Website or Services for any or no reason, with or without notice. Without limiting the foregoing, we will terminate your account access immediately if: (i) you fail to cooperate with or provide information for an investigation by a local, state, or federal government agency; or you violate any provision of these Terms or breach any representation or warranty; (ii) your account remains suspended for more than 30 days due to nonpayment; your account activity violates any local, federal, or state laws.
- b. You may delete your account at any time without prior notice.
- c. Sections that by their nature should survive termination will continue in full force after termination. Termination does not limit any other rights or remedies we may have at law or in equity. Sections **0–2, 5–14, 16.c, 17–18** survive termination.
- d. Where feasible, we may provide a **limited window** to export your permitted data before termination (excluding data we must retain by law).

18. Electronic Communication.

- a. We, or our affiliates, may be required to provide certain legal/regulatory disclosures, periodic statements and confirmations, notices, tax forms, and other communications (collectively, "**Communications**") to you in writing. By agreeing to these Terms, you consent to receive

Communications electronically, including by email. Your consent applies to each year Communications are furnished. If you no longer have account access to receive electronic Communications, you may request paper copies.

- b. You agree that all terms, agreements, notices, disclosures, and other communications we provide electronically satisfy any legal requirement that they be in writing. We will use reasonable efforts to honor requests to opt out of certain emails. With respect to these Terms, you waive any rights to require an original signature, non-electronic delivery, or retention of non-electronic records, to the extent permitted by law.

19. Miscellaneous.

- a. Entire Agreement. These Terms constitute the entire and exclusive agreement between you and us regarding your access to and use of the Website and Services.
- b. No Waiver. Failure to require performance of any provision does not affect our right to require performance later, nor does a waiver of any breach or default constitute a waiver of any subsequent breach or default or of the provision itself.
- c. Severability. If any part of these Terms is held invalid or unenforceable, that part shall be enforced to the maximum extent possible, and the remainder will continue in full force and effect.
- d. Governing Law. These Terms are governed by the laws of Georgia, without regard to conflict-of-laws principles. However, any additional mandatory consumer rights and protections available to you under the laws of your country of residence will also apply.
- e. Arbitration. Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or relating to these Terms (including any question regarding their existence, validity, interpretation, performance, breach, or termination) shall be finally resolved by arbitration under the UNCITRAL Arbitration Rules in force on the date the Notice of Arbitration is submitted. The appointing authority shall be the Georgian International Arbitration Centre. The seat (legal place) of arbitration shall be Tbilisi, Georgia. The language of the arbitration shall be English. The tribunal shall consist of a sole arbitrator, unless the parties agree in writing to a three-member tribunal. Any award shall be final and binding upon the parties, and judgment upon the award may be entered in any court having jurisdiction. Each party shall bear its own costs and expenses (including legal fees) and an equal share of the tribunal's and administrative fees, unless the tribunal decides otherwise in the final award.
- f. Class Action Waiver. To the maximum extent permitted by law, you and we agree that no dispute may be brought, heard, or arbitrated as a class action (including opt-out or opt-in class actions), or in a representative or private attorney general capacity on behalf of a class or the general public. All disputes must be resolved on an individual basis only.
- g. Assignment. You may not assign, delegate, subcontract, or otherwise transfer your rights or obligations under these Terms. The Company may transfer, assign, delegate, subcontract, or otherwise transfer its rights and obligations without notice or consent.
